- 3. Matters Arising -

Warm Spaces has ended after 11 weeks – lack of numbers. A long-term idea (e.g. club for the lonely elderly) should be considered, and would need volunteers. Sunday after Mass coffee could be resurrected.

Neighbourhood volunteers - 48 have signed up to assist.

Confirmation candidates; Canon will publicise date of meeting (a poster and flyers will be produced Comms Group.)
