

With holidays, almost, behind us; schools reopened, and some of our young people preparing to begin university, there is a sense of a new beginning. New beginnings can be a time when we can reflect on ourselves, and so they can be a moment when we will recognise a need to change, within ourselves.

And that is true of our life of faith also, our life as disciples of Jesus, there is always more to do, more to discover; the question is always there for us, to heed and to answer: what else do I need to do. What else do I need to do, if I am to demonstrate that I am a disciple of Jesus?

To be a disciple, is to faithfully follow Jesus. Even with the best of intentions, it's easy to become lukewarm, perhaps to be half-hearted. A new beginning is a time to ask: what else can I do? Where can I put more effort in, and so become more committed? At the centre of our lives is the celebration of the Eucharist. How important is this in my life? Do I appreciate it, sufficiently, to ensure that I attend Mass every Sunday, so that it is a genuine priority, something that I truly appreciate, and cherish, and don't want to miss? Or is it something that I make up my own 'rules' about attendance, and easily excuse myself if something prevents me from attending?

We need to share faithfully in the Mass, because it gives us the nourishment we need, if we are to be faithful disciples of Jesus. We need to grow in appreciating the wonderful gift we are generously, and lovingly, given. This could be a time to hear anew the calling to be faithful, and enthusiastic disciples of Jesus.

#### FARMERS' SEEDS UNDER THREAT

Seeds are life! Small farmers across the globe have traditionally swapped and shared seeds for their produce. However, their right to choose their own seeds is under threat. Laws are being introduced across the world that limit what farmers can do with these seeds. These laws, which are being brought in with the support of large financial institutions such as the World Bank, overwhelmingly favour large agribusinesses. Instead of being allowed to choose their own seeds, small farmers must purchase commercial seeds - good for big business profits, but damaging for the small farmers. Protecting the freedom of farmers to choose seeds is a right we must all stand up for if we are to tackle global poverty. CAFOD's food campaign is urging the UK government to protect the right of farmers around the world to use their seeds. To add your voice, please sign the letter to the World Bank President.
