#### PRIESTS TRAINING FUND

Next Sunday, the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, is also 'Good Shepherd 'Sunday, when we are asked to especially pray for vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. Fr Javier Ruiz, Vice-Rector at Allen Hall, will be speaking at the Masses on Sunday morning about the work of Priestly formation, and asking for your help.
