Each year, the Church invites us to celebrate the *Sunday of the Word of God*—a moment to renew our love for the Scriptures and to recognise the place of God’s Word at the heart of our Christian life. This is not simply a day to admire the Bible as a sacred book, but to rediscover it as a living word, spoken by God to us here and now.

The Scriptures continue to speak to every generation, because they reveal who God is, and who we are called to be. When we listen attentively at Mass, it is Christ himself who speaks to us. The Word proclaimed is not just information; it is invitation—an invitation to faith, to conversion, and to hope.

In a world full of noise, opinions, and many distractions, the Word of God offers a different voice: steady, truthful, and life-giving. It challenges us when we are comfortable, consoles us when we are weary, and guides us when the way ahead is unclear. Many of us keep a Bible at home, but this Sunday gently asks: do we open it? Do we allow God’s Word to shape our thinking, our decisions, and our relationships?

Both St Jerome, and Pope Francis remind us that “*ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.*” To know Jesus more deeply, we must become familiar with the Scriptures. This need not be complicated: reading the Gospel of the day, spending a few quiet minutes with a psalm, or reflecting on a line that stays with us can be enough.

On this Sunday of the Word of God, let us renew our commitment to listen more carefully, both in church and in our daily lives. May the Word we hear take root in our hearts, so that it may bear fruit in lives of faith, love, and service.

ARCHBISHOP'S INSTALLATION

Our Archbishop-elect, Richard Moth will be installed as Archbishop of Westminster on Saturday 14th February, during Mass, at Westminster Cathedral. Admission to this celebration, is by ticket only. Each parish, in the Diocese, has been allocated just one ticket for the Mass of Installation.

On the evening before, Friday 13 February 2026 at 5.30pm, there will be a celebration of Solemn Vespers also in Westminster Cathedral, at which the Archbishop-elect will preach. For this liturgy, each parish has been allocated two tickets.

PROTECTING LIFE

The House of Lords will debate the amendment related to abortion up-to-birth, on the last day of the Committee Stage either on 27th January 2026 or 2nd February 2026. This is a very worrying development. Please write to members of the House of Lords and ask them to fight the extreme abortion up-to-birth amendment. This was not in any party's manifesto. It was passed after just forty - three minutes of MPs' backbench debate. Please take a leaflet after Mass with details on how to contact a member of the House of Lords e.g. you can scan the QR code on the leaflet or type <https://spuc.org.uk/campaign/abortion-decriminalisation> into your browser. This online tool brings up a suggested Peer for

you contact either with instructions on posting it to the Peer or emailing it to him/her. Alternatively, you can send a physical letter written in your own words. These are the most impactful. The address is simply (Name of Peer,) House of Lords, London, SW1A OPW.
