

FROM THE CARDINAL:

The Bishops of England and Wales met together in Cardiff for a few days at the beginning of this month. Among the matters we discussed was the return of Catholics to Mass, in the light of the improved situation with Covid.

To want to attend Mass is a hallmark of Catholic faith, and we do so with deep gratitude and joy. The Bishops noted that, thankfully, the pressing challenges of the pandemic have lessened significantly. The vast majority of people have been able to resume the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted because of Covid. Therefore, the Bishops believe that there are no longer any reasons related to the pandemic which prevent Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. We appreciate that there will still be some Catholics who, for reasons of health, do not feel it is safe to return to Mass. It has always been the Church's understanding that any Catholic whose freedom to physically attend Mass is impeded, for example, because of ill health or caring for the sick or legitimate fear, is not in breach of the Sunday obligation.

Our Catholic communities have benefitted significantly from the online provision of Mass during the pandemic. While virtual attendance of Mass online does not fulfil the Sunday obligation, it may be of continued spiritual comfort to the sick and elderly who cannot attend in person and for whom the obligation does not apply.

In the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Lord Jesus has entrusted to us the precious gift of himself. We are a Eucharistic people for whom attendance at Sunday Mass is essential. As we look forward to the forthcoming celebration of Pentecost, the Bishops invite all Catholics who have not done so to now return to attending Sunday Mass in person. Nourished by our encounter with the risen Lord, and by his Word and his Body and Blood, we receive the strength, week by week, to serve and glorify the Lord by our lives.

ATTENDING MASS

As you will have read, in the Cardinal's message, the obligation to attend Mass every Sunday, is to be restored from next Sunday. As has always been the case, the exception being where someone is prevented from doing so, by reason of health, or when caring for a sick person. Presently our attendance is reduced by between 200 and 300 parishioners, in other words some 40% are missing! It would be good if I could personally invite, encourage back, those who have yet to return, but that is a tall order. It is rather a duty we can all share, to encourage back the missing 40%, it's a task, a mission we can all take



on. If, you know someone who doesn't attend Mass, at present, then do encourage them to attend, let them know that they are missed, and that they will be most welcome.

CAFOD FIX THE FOOD SYSTEM THE PARADOX OF ABUNDANCE


