In our gospel today, Jesus brings his disciples away from noise and busyness, and takes them up a mountain. This is not unusual in itself. We know from the gospels that Jesus himself often went to the mountain top to pray on his own. While they are on the mountain, something very strange and unusual happens. Jesus is changed in a very dramatic way; and Peter is able to proclaim: 'Lord it is wonderful for us to be here.

As we continue our Lenten journey and Jesus continues his own, maybe this brief glimpse of Jesus in all his glory is also meant for us today. Perhaps like the disciples, we too experience fear, doubt and even a lack of faith. Perhaps we too need to be encouraged and strengthened by Jesus, especially as we continue our journey through Lent. We too need to know that our prayer, fasting and sharing with the poor is not an end in itself, or that it is all done in vain. We are heading towards the resurrection and the new life of Easter, but we have a distance to go yet. The experience of Jesus transformed offers each of us a taste of what lies ahead of us.

This is the hope in which we are asked to have faith as we make our way through Lent. When we are tempted to give up and give in, let us look to Jesus changed and transformed. We may see in him the future that is promised to us, not only at Easter but in the fullness of God's Kingdom. As we continue to make our way through Lent, let us do what the voice of God says to each of us; 'This is my Son, Listen to him.'



#### FRIDAYS IN LENT

Each Friday of Lent, Mass will be celebrated at 7.00pm, followed by the Stations of the Cross. Friday is the traditional day for 'making the Stations', so attending Mass, and the Stations of the Cross, during Lent, is a positive activity during this season.

# LENT GROUPS

The Lent groups will be meeting throughout Lent to reflect, share ideas and pray. The sessions will be based on Praying the Our Father, by Carl E. Olson which is described by one theologian as "the best collection of Lenten reflections she has seen." The booklet is available from CTS Books  $\pounds$ 3.50 or at the meeting.

But for now, at least, we will stop offering our undercroft as a 'Warm Space'. Again, a big 'thank you' to those who gave their time; perhaps we can look at other ways of offering support, to those who might appreciate some company. Suggestions welcome!

#### GOOD NEIGHBOURS'

As part of the Parish Renewal programme, and as you know from the recent requests seeking area volunteers, we have been working on, and are now ready to launch "Good Neighbours'.

This initiative answers the call to become a more open and welcoming parish, as highlighted in the feedback from the parish survey, exemplified by, 'The parish being a much stronger community, where everyone feels welcome, and not alone whatever their personal situation, and there is much more looking out for people including non-Catholics'.

As shown on the map at the back of the church, you can see the parish has been divided into several small areas, each with its own representatives, who will keep contact with the parishioners in their own area.

The aim is to develop a local community in each area by :

- dropping a newsletter through a letter box to those unable to leave home
- welcome new catholic neighbours
- let the parish office know of any specific needs of parishioners in that area (for example a need for transport to go to Mass, request of a visit of a Eucharistic minister...)
- just say "hello" or keep telephone contact with parishioners who may not be well, or in need of a friendly chat.

As the map highlights, the red sections show which areas are not yet covered by volunteers, and the yellow sections show areas where there are some, but not enough volunteers for the number of households, so we would be grateful if anyone could step forward to help cover these areas.
