Words such as "commands" and "commandments", may sound somewhat out of place when we are speaking of friendship and love. We may not associate "commands" with friendship and love, because those we count as our friends, are not usually in the habit of commanding, or ordering, us to do what they want. We derive little joy from being ordered to do something.

Not, that there can be any ignoring those commands to friendship and love. God, presented in the gospel passage as "Father", loves Jesus. Jesus remains or abides in God's love so deeply, that this love flows on to his friends. They are to love one another as Jesus has loved them. This is his commandment or commission to them and, by extension, to us. It directs them/us to live for each other and put their lives/our lives on the line for one another.

Countless doctors and nurses, carers, and many others, across the globe are doing precisely that right now. Remaining in the love of God or of Jesus and doing what God or Jesus commands, seem to be one and the same thing. In other words, love is not just an emotion: it is always expressed in action that is in tune with, and for the sake of the other. The disciples need no further explanation.

Jesus' whole life and his courage in the face of impending death, have shown them what it means to love one another. Living in the friendship of Christ's disciples, is not some abstract goal. Too often we affirm the goodness of our selfless companions on the journey, only when we come to lay them to rest. As we approach the end of the Easter season, we might give thanks for the love of our friends, for their witness to holiness, and for the joy that they bring to our lives.
