

We are currently looking for a dynamic, proactive and experienced PA to support the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia. These are two roles but carried out by one person, currently Monsignor Gerry Ewing, who is also a Trustee of the Archdiocese. All of his work is associated with the management and running of the Archdiocese. This job is based at Archbishop's House, 150 St George's Road, London SE1 6HX and role exists to provide support to him in all aspects of his work.

The key responsibilities include diary, meeting and travel management, dealing with correspondence and phone calls, undertaking research, producing reports and presentations and extensive liaison with senior clergy, lay staff, trustees and external professionals.

The ideal candidate will be Catholic, with a good knowledge of the workings of a parish and a diocese.
