

It can sometimes happen, that when we tell another person something that has happened to us, we are not believed. We share an experience in good faith, hoping to be listened to, and believed, but the opposite happens. This can upset and even anger us. In the gospel this Sunday, as Jesus sends out his disciples, he prepares them for the possibility of such a response to their message. Either they will be welcomed, and able to minister fruitfully, or they will be rejected and their ministry will not be accepted. Jesus is not asking them to do anything, he has not already done or experienced himself.

Not everyone who heard him accepted his message, and often he was rejected and run out of town! This is not surprising as his message was, and still is, very challenging. The message Jesus speaks is one of mercy, love of strangers and even enemies, forgiveness, and concern for the poor and neglected.

Jesus called each of these disciples personally and then sent them out in his name. He trusted them with the responsibility of carrying out his mission and ministry. Today, Jesus calls each of us by our name, and entrusts us with the same responsibility. Today, each of us is asked by Jesus to not only to hear and believe in him, we are called to share this good news whenever, and wherever, we can.

Through our Baptism, we are called to be missionary disciples. We do this through the quality of the example of our lives. The church teaches us that, the gospel must be proclaimed by witness. Jesus has called each of us by our name, he has filled each of us with his Spirit, and sends us out in his name; we are not alone.

FIRST COMMUNION 2024

It is that time of year, when parents are invited to consider if they would like their children to be prepared for First Holy Communion next year. This year the arrangements are a little different. Over the years it has become a source of concern, that quite a number of the



First Communion families, do not regularly attend Mass each week. This year the hope is that parents can be encouraged to take the promises, made at their children's

Baptism, more seriously. These new arrangements are not 'closing the door' on anyone, but a pathway to a renewed and deeper commitment. Parents who would like their child to be enrolled for First Holy Communion preparation, need to make an appointment to meet with Canon Dwyer. To participate in the programme, children for the programme should be in Year 3 from September 2023, or above. To make an appointment, please call the Parish Office, Monday to Thursday, between 9.30am and 12.30pm. Parent(s) and child should attend the appointment. If the child was not Baptised at Our Lady of Lourdes, please bring a copy of their Baptism Certificate.

JOIN A COURSE RUN BY HARPENDEN LEARNING FOR LEISURE (HLFL)

If you are interested in the world, keen to keep your brain active and want to participate in an activity with like minded people then an HLfL course may just be what you are looking for. HLfL is a notfor-profit organisation run by local people. We run courses on a wide range of topics, each led by an experienced professional. Fees are payable, but are set at a level to only cover costs.
