Key actions of the meeting

- 1. **Create a list of First Aiders** that can be posted next to where bottles of waters are available near the stairs to go to the organ upstairs [Father Anthony to ask Melanie]
- 2. **Parish Bazar:** the parish Christmas bazaar was set for December 6th, 2025 and it is the last time that Marva will run it. There is a need to find people to learn how to organise it this year for the next one. [Father Anthony to ask Melanie to make an announcement]
- 3. **Termly Meetings:** Restart termly meetings with group leaders (Baptism, FHC, Children's liturgy, Choir, Confirmation, Youth Group, Mariage preparation, etc.), with a clear agenda and chairperson. [Katie Metcalf and Andrew Belderbos to organise catechist meeting]
- Parish Diary: Create and maintain a parish diary to keep track of events and activities (First Holy Communion and Confirmation preparation dates, Youth Friendly masses, retreat, etc.), with Melanie suggested as the person responsible. [Father Anthony to ask Melanie]
- 5. Confirmation catechists: There are still 3 to 4 catechists required to run the confirmation course this year with a need for an administration role specifically. Note that Anna Painter has offered to help for the administration role [Father Anthony to make announcement at the end of masses]
- 6. OLoL Presence outside the church: consider updating the poster outside in front of the church according to the liturgical seasons (e.g. for Advent, Eastertide, etc.) [Father Anthony plans to speak to Communication team] + consider creating a banner for the parish that can be put outside the church before masses [Father Anthony to consider and speak with Sinead]
- 7. **Alpha Courses:** Consider running Alpha courses (or other such as Sycamore) to deepen faith and attract new members, and advertise these courses to the wider community. [Father Anthony to consider]
- 8. **Install a defibrillator in the parish:** Andrew Belderbos to speak to John Williams if the Catenian would still like to fund a **defibrillator for the parish**
- 9. **PPC Secretary Roles:** Thank you to Andrew Belderbos who has accepted to become take on the Secretary role. Father Anthony to nominate a Chair for the PPC.
- 10. List of groups: the list of groups and PPC connect persons have been updated

- 11. "Parishioners commitment": Following reviews of dropping attendance numbers at masses (530 vs. 730 pre-Covid), of children preparing for First Holy Communion (35) and for Confirmation (25) for how to encourage people to come to church [Father Anthony to consider ways to ask people why they are not coming to church]
- 12. "Be welcoming in the broader sense": consider doing a "welcoming event" for new parishioners, and to wish "Happy Birthday" to people who will have / had their birthday recently [Father Anthony to consider organising such event]
- 13. Coffee after 9.45 am and 11.30am mass on 21/09: will be organised by Claire Belderbos and Jane Rose. Suggestion was made to invite people at the end of the mass: "Please come down for a coffee" and make an announcement the week before [Father Anthony to ask Melanie to include this information in the Newsletter + Andrew Belberbos to connect with Jane Rose for the 9.45am coffee]
