- Opening Prayer said by Canon Anthony.
- 1. Welcome & Apologies -
 - Sarah (work.)
- 2. Minutes of last meeting -
 - The April minutes (corrected version) needed to be sent to Canon for publication.
- 3. Matters Arising -
 - Welcome Team needs support (more people needed.)
- Parish Website
 - Alison presented the new Parish website in its development version.
 - Necessary preparatory work had been interrupted by Covid.
 - It is designed to reflect the recent work done following the Parish Survey etc., and to appeal to different groups.
 - The idea was not simply to be factual, but to give a sense of the vibrancy of the parish and its work, and to encourage participation.
 - A feedback form might be included.
 - Hoping to go live next week.
 - Alison was congratulated for the excellence of her team's work.
 - Suggestions from PPC: Resources should be moved to a different section; PPC should have an email address (this was agreed); how do we keep in touch with those without computers? Hard copy newsletters is one way.
- 5. Family & Young People Project
 - Need to communicate plan at Mass and through social media.
 - Fernanda and Tony were willing to speak at the end of Mass, possibly after a fortnight's awareness raising.
 - The Comms Team would be approached for advice.
 - Volunteers before summer a possibility.
 - Fernanda would email another document that she had produced on the project.
- 6. Follow up to Synodal Pathway & Parish Survey -
 - LGBT the issue was more about acceptance by the Church as an institution, rather than people feeling not welcomed at a parish level; the PPC discussed whether more could still be done at a parish level to ensure that LGBT people were welcome; the importance of ensuring that people had a clear view of what the Church actually taught was stressed; it was also understood that communication in general was important.
 - Fernanda presented her PowerPoint on consolidation of the Synodal Pathway and Parish Survey.
 - 6 areas had been identified to expand discussions:
- a) Children, Youth and family/Involving and nurturing the young
- b) Greater parishioner engagement /A sense of community and belonging
- c) Guiding and supporting our spiritual journey/A supportive parish
- d) Welcoming and inclusive of everyone
- e) A vibrant, growing and evolving parish/An outward-looking parish
- f) A Church we are proud of telling about to others

- Fernanda raised a number of questions / issues that needed to be followed up: people like the church but perhaps there is something missing in their experience; this may be to do with the need for deeper spiritual interactions and faith understanding, and how the church approaches issues of inclusion; in particular people are wondering what the next step after the Synodal Pathway might be; the importance of 'quick wins' where possible was stressed, e.g. resources for faith development listed on the website; another issue raised was how to support those who still had concerns about historic abuse; Faith Development needed its own group.
- Thanks were expressed to Fernanda for her work.
